

Climate Science Researcher/Writer for MIT Climate Primer

The MIT Climate Primer (climateprimer.mit.edu), written by MIT EAPS Professor Emeritus Kerry Emanuel and produced by the MIT Environmental Solutions Initiative (ESI), is an award-winning digital chapter book that reviews the science, risks and solutions to climate change. The website was produced in 2019 and won a Webby Award in 2020.

The ESI is seeking a graduate student with a background in climate science to work with ESI's MIT Climate team to review and update the Primer with citations and the latest climate research. Work includes reviewing climate science literature, identifying and updating references, and suggesting revisions.

Applicants must be graduate students who are strong writers and familiar with the latest major works in climate science, including the IPCC reports. Experience in science communication is preferred but not required.

This is a temporary position totaling approximately 40 hours, paying an MIT graduate student rate of \$20-\$25 per hour. Pay within this range is commensurate with experience. Work will be done independently and in collaboration with the ESI Program Director and Prof. Kerry Emanuel, and may be completed remotely or in the ESI office on campus.
